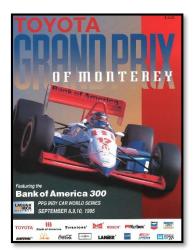

History of IndyCar at Laguna Seca







- October 1983 Inaugural IndyCar race at Laguna Seca
 - World-renowned drivers: Mario Andretti, Al Unser Jr., Bobby Unser, Rick Mears, Johnny Rutherford, Gordon Johncock and A.J. Foyt
- 1983-2004 Laguna Seca annually hosted IndyCar races
- 1984-1987 Bobby Rahal won four consecutive races
 - Rahal Straight named in honor of his achievements
- 1994 Mario Andretti officially ended his competitive driving career at Laguna Seca
- 1996 Alex Zanardi's now famous daring last lap overtake of Bryan Herta known as "The Pass"
- 2000 Team Penske's secured 6th victory; the most wins for a single race team
