Smoking Ban at all County Parks, Buildings and Parking Lots

Board of Supervisors Meeting, August 28, 2018

Overview

- Chapter 10.70 "Smoking Pollution Control"
 - Established 1993
 - Prohibits smoking in County owned or leased facilities and vehicles
 - Prohibits smoking in public places
- Chapter 14.12 "County Parks"
 - Established 1970, amended
 - No regulations relative to smoking

Timeline: Smoking Ordinance Update

January 2017- Health Dept. initiates smoking regulation update

- Chapter 10.70: Modernize language, clarify restrictions, match State legal changes.
- Chapter 14.12 Address smoking in County Parks (majority of update).

August 2017 - Smoking regulation presented to Parks Commission

- Support restrictions in County Parks, exceptions for designated smoking areas at Royal Oaks, Toro, San Lorenzo, Laguna Seca and Lakes.
- January 2018 Board adopts Health Dept. smoking policy
 - Bans smoking at all County facilities.
- July 2018 Board Referral requesting draft ordinance to prohibit smoking in all County parks, buildings and parking lots.

County Smoking Policy

- Smoking and the use of tobacco products is prohibited in all buildings and facilities, both indoors and outdoors, and inside vehicles owned, leased, and/or operated by the County of Monterey.
- This policy and procedure is applicable to all County of Monterey employees, volunteers, contracted staff, patients, and visitors.

Range of Options for Smoking Regulations in County Parks

Total Ban

- All areas of all County Parks
- No exceptions (living quarters, large events, etc.)

Ban with Exceptions

- Designated areas set by location, event type, park use, etc.
- Exceptions may be broad or limited in scope.
- No Ban
 - Current Code
- Other Counties

Examples

Examples of Parks Smoking Regulations in Other Counties

- Smoking restrictions lifted for specific public events.
 - Santa Barbara County
- Exemptions or delayed implementation for parks and buildings under a management contract or lease.
 - Santa Clara County
- Phased or delayed implementation for all smoking bans.
 - Sonoma County

Parks Commission Recommendation

- Total smoking ban in all County Parks with special consideration for:
 - Live-on volunteers to smoke within their own living quarters.
 - Enterprise fund facilities (Laguna Seca, Lake San Antonio and Lake Nacimiento).
 - Use of medicinal cannabis in County Parks.

Recommended Actions

- Consider recommendations by the Parks Commission regarding implementing smoking regulations at County Park facilities
- Provide staff direction:
 - Chapter 14.12 (County Parks) smoking regulations in County Parks specifically.
 - Chapter 10.70 (Smoking Pollution Control) smoking regulations for County facilities in general.
- Ordinances come to the full Board for adoption.
