AMENDMENT #1 TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY & STERIYCLE, INC

- 3. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the AGREEMENT are unchanged and unaffected by this AMENDMENT and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the AGREEMENT.
- 4. A copy of the AMENDMENT shall be attached to the original AGREEMENT executed by the County on July 1, 2018.

Requested Language Modification to Standard County Agreement

CONTRACTOR requests the following language changes to the County's Standard Agreement. These changes have been discussed with CONTRACTOR, and CONTRACTOR is aware that these changes will require Board of Supervisors Approval.

Section 7.02

Remove:

"effective immediately upon written notice to CONTRACTOR"

Replace with:

"upon CONTRACTOR's failure to cure a defect within ten (10) days upon written notice"

New language with change:

The County may cancel and terminate this Agreement for good cause upon CONTRACTOR'S failure to cure a defect within ten (10) days upon written notice. "Good cause" includes the failure of CONTRACTOR to perform the required services at the time and in the manner provided under this Agreement. If County terminates this Agreement for good cause, the County may be relieved of the payment of any consideration to CONTRACTOR, and the County may proceed with the work in any manner, which County deems proper. The cost to the County shall be deducted from any sum due the CONTRACTOR under this Agreement.
