Upon motion of Director LeBarre and seconded by Director Sullivan, and carried by those members present, the Board of Directors hereby:

Recommends that the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Supervisors:

- a. Approve and adopt a FY 2020-21 cost of living adjustment (COLA) increase of 2.9% for Zones 2B, 2Y and 2Z for the Castroville Seawater Intrusion Project (CSIP) and the Salinas Valley Reclamation Project (SVRP); and
- b. Approve and adopt a FY 2020-21 COLA increase of 2.9% for the CSIP water delivery charge and water service charge; and
- c. Set and hold a public hearing on June 2, 2020 at 1:30 PM to consider approving and adopting assessment rate charges; and
- d. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to publish a hearing notice once a week for two consecutive weeks prior to the date set for the hearing.
