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Hi Nicki.

The risk of cocci exposure for employees at the site was known before the original project started. The article that was included in the opposition does not represent information about risk of exposure that was not already known to public health.

If the company follows the same hazard mitigation requirements used for the original project, then the proposed modification should not represent a risk of exposure to cocci that is different than the risk of exposure to cocci during the original project.

However, the risk of exposure is dependent in part on how well the company adheres to the mitigation requirements.

I think the response is satisfactory.

Good Morning, Dr. Moreno, Ms. Michie,

I am writing to request your insights related to the Cal Flats project. In April 2020, the applicant applied for a minor amendment to the broader Cal Flats project to add a battery energy storage system within the "solar development area" footprint of the previously approved project. Accordingly, EHB staff did not raise this minor amendment to your attention during project review. EHB recommended approval of this minor amendment with no additional conditions of approval; however, all of the existing conditions of approval associated with the project would remain in effect and apply to this amendment as well. Specifically, various conditions related to Valley Fever management. A summary of the proposed amendment is attached as **IDR_EHB_PLN120294-AMD1_041620**.

The County has received a letter of opposition to the minor amendment, based on failure of the County to conduct additional environmental review that would address "the significant increase in Valley Fever identified since the publication of the prior EIR." The document titled **4834-001acp**

– 2020-05-19 Cal Flats Solar Energy Storage Modification Comments with Attachment, is a copy of the letter. In response, the County's environmental consultant, Denise Duffy & Associates has prepared a response which indicates the reasons why additional environmental analysis is not warranted. The full DD&A response is attached as <u>CFS BESS Modification –</u> <u>Valley Fever Response 05212020.pdf</u> To summarize, DD&A opines the following:

As discussed in the attached, it is our opinion that the County of Monterey appropriately evaluated the effects associated with the Proposed Modification and that a supplemental or subsequent EIR is not warranted. Moreover, the Proposed Modification will comply with all applicable mitigation measures identified in the CFS Project EIR, including the comprehensive set of mitigation measures intended to address potential Valley Fever concerns. These measures include, among other things, that the Applicant prepare a detailed Valley Fever Management Plan in consultation with a licensed medical physician specializing in pulmonary epidemiology. This plan will be completed prior to the start of construction and will be subject to the review and approval of the Monterey County Health Department. Compliance with existing mitigation measures identified in the CFS Project EIR would ensure that the Proposed Modification would not result in any additional environmental effects beyond those identified in the CFS Project EIR. As a result, a supplemental or subsequent EIR is not warranted and the County appropriately evaluated the effects associated with the Proposed Modification consistent with CEQA Guidelines Sec. 15164.

I am requesting on behalf of the EHB and RMA-Planning Department, your consideration of the DD&A response. Do you concur that the existing applicable mitigation measures to address potential Valley Fever concerns are adequate to protect health & safety? You can access the comprehensive list of conditions and mitigations assigned to this application by viewing the RESbos_15-027_Revised_PLN120294_021015, which is saved to the cloud due to its large size.. I do not expect you to make a determination on whether additional CEQA is warranted, but request your opinion on the adequacy of the existing mitigations and plans already in place. RMA has indicated their desire to respond by next Wednesday, May 27th. In light of your other priorities revolving around COVID-19, I am unsure if this will be a reasonable time frame for you, but please respond to let us know when may be able to assess this concern. I thank you in advance for your time.
