# Background

- Development Project Conditions/Mitigations require Arch and Tribal Monitors
  - Mapping and Land Use Policies
  - Protect resources
  - Code enforcement for non-compliance
- Current penalties codified in section 1.22.100
  - First Day: \$100
  - Second Day: \$200
  - ▶ Third Day and Beyond: \$500/day
- Creates "One Size Fits All" penalty structure
- Board Direction to explore increased penalties
- Staff seeking direction on priority

# Ordinance Development

- Modified through ordinance and/or policy
- Considerations:
  - ▶ Title 1 (General Enforcement) vs. Title 20/21 (Zoning) vs. Land Use Plan
  - New Code section vs. Amendment
  - Coordination with other jurisdictions
  - Stakeholder outreach
    - State Native American Heritage Commission
    - ► Local Tribes
    - ▶ Public Interest Groups
    - Other?
  - County Technical Advisory Panel (NAARTAP)
- State Legislation

## Penalty Increase Considerations

- Proportionality Legal research
  - State Regulations
  - Court Cases
- Countywide equity of increased penalty
  - Coastal vs. Inland
- Alternative and/or additional forms of penalties
- Additional monitoring
  - ▶ 3<sup>rd</sup> party vs. County staff
- Other violations needing enhanced penalties
  - ▶ E.G.: Unpermitted Tree Removal, ESHA Damage, etc.

### Staff Resources

- Combined effort RMA Planning and Counsel
- Estimate +/- 6 Months if assigned as a top priority
  - Depends on amount of outreach
  - Will require other work to be set aside
- Impact to 2020 RMA Workplan:

  - Ordinances: ADU, Mixed Use, Landscape, Vacation Rentals
  - Plans: Big Sur LUP, Moss Landing CP, Chualar CP, Castroville CP
