Approval of GSP for 180/400



Timeline and Actions

- October 10, 2019, SVBGSA Board requested that Monterey County become the GSA for either the entire 180/400 Foot Aquifer Subbasin or the CEMEX site. Board also requested the County to adopt the SVBGSA Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) as the GSP for the entire basin.
- December 11, 2019 the County of Monterey elected to become the GSA over the CEMEX site. On December 18, 2019, DWR accepted the County GSA's filing. SVBGSA modified boundaries to eliminate overlap.
- January 9, 2020 the SVBGSA Board adopted the GSP for the 180/400-foot aquifer except for the CEMEX site that covers the MCGSA and declined to enter into a Cooperation Agreement until details were clarified with the County GSA.

History and Timeline Continued

- January 28, 2020, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors acting as County GSA adopted a resolution approving a Cooperation Agreement with the SVBGSA designating SVBGSA as the entity that will implement the Plan for the CEMEX site. The County GSA also requested that SVBGSA adopt the GSP as to the CEMEX site.
- Board directed County staff to begin notification process that will allow the County GSA to consider adoption of the Plan.
- January 30, 2020, the SVBGSA Board adopted a resolution approving a Cooperation Agreement with the MCGSA that would designate the SVBGSA as the entity that will implement the Plan for the CEMEX site.

Status of 180/400 Foot Aquifer GSP

- GSP submitted on time.
- Completed DWR extended public comment period (12 letters received).
- Implementation of some Management Actions are underway.
- DWR continues agency review –legislation allows two years for review to be completed.
- First Annual Report submitted on time.
