## January 13, 2020 County Service Area 1 Citizens Advisory Committee

Lynette: Here are the key points that our Committee made at our October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 meeting, which we would like to have sent to Melanie Beretti and Carl Holm:

CSA-1 approved the expenditure of \$100,000 of its fund balance in support of the Lagoon and Scenic Road EIR Preparation, with the following recommendations:

- 1. All of our CSA-1 approved funds should be used in support of the SRPS Project, which is within our jurisdiction.
- 2. Our \$100,000 contribution to the overall \$450,000 funding approved by the County should preferably be used for the Technical Studies and in particular a Geotech Study to determine the underlying bedrock along the Scenic Road bluffs and to estimate sand loss from a mid-slope or low-toe seawall.
- 3. The County RMA will ascertain the State Coastal Commission's project requirements before many more funds are spent on the EIR preparation.
- 4. The County RMA will utilize a highly competent Geotech/hydrology firm with a track record of installing seawalls along the Central Coast, such as Haro Kasunich.
- 5. The County RMA will move expeditiously to finalize the MOU with the State Parks that will allow for a future easement to install a seawall and conduct borings along the Scenic Road bluffs on State Parks land.

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
