

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Ord Veterans' Cemetery Citizens' Advisory Committee (CCAC) was formed with the primary purpose to assist in developing a Business Plan and Implementation Plan for the development of the proposed California Central Coast Veterans' Cemetery (CCVC) to be located on the former Fort Ord; and

**WHEREAS**, CCAC's specific areas of effort included: to liaison with elected federal, state, and county officials; to liaison with the media to build public support; to establish a liaison network with county veterans' organizations; to explore the use of the Fort Ord Reuse Authority (FORA) for funding; to work with a "technical staff working group" formed for the purpose of working on Veterans' Cemetery issues at Fort Ord; to improve contact with the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet); to establish liaisons with veteran groups in adjacent counties regarding the CCVC; and to liaison with the Central Coast Veterans' Cemetery Foundation (CCVCF); and

**WHEREAS**, the CCVC opened on October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and through CCAC's efforts has received adequate funding to support an ongoing phased construction plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monterey County Military and Veteran Affairs Advisory Commission (MVAAC) currently serves as the liaison with elected federal, state, and county officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the CCVCF serves as the liaison with the media to continue public support; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the CCVC has been secured and FORA was dissolved on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, CalVet is providing technical assistance for the purpose of working on Veterans' Cemetery issues at Fort Ord; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monterey County Military and Veteran Affairs Office (MVAO) liaisons with County Veteran Service Offices (CVSOs) in adjacent counties regarding the CCVC; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Veterans' Council (UVC) serves as the liaison network of county veterans' organizations and has assumed the CCAC responsibilities as the liaison to the CCVCF;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors for the County of Monterey as follows:

1. Dissolving the Fort Ord Veterans' Cemetery Citizens' Advisory Committee is authorized and approved.

2. CCAC Members and ex-officio members are encouraged to join, attend meetings, and work with the United Veterans' Council and/or the Monterey County Military and Veteran Affairs Advisory Commission.


