That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution to authorize the Resource Management Agency (RMA) Director, or their successor department head, to submit a grant application for up to \$5,147,149 in competitive grant funding from the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) Coastal Watershed Flood Risk Reduction Grant Program for the Carmel River Floodplain Restoration and Environmental Enhancement (CRFREE) Project and take all required actions for submittal, including obtaining Counsel's signature on the verification page;
- b. That pursuant and subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 (Proposition 1; Wat. Code, § 79700 et seq.), the RMA shall submit a proposal to obtain funding for the CRFREE Project from DWR;

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey is a Government Agency with responsibility for the Carmel River Floodplain Restoration and Environmental Enhancement Project (CRFREE Project);

WHEREAS, the CRFREE Project is a multi-benefit, green infrastructure project that will reduce flood risk and restore riverine habitat where natural and built environments intersect at the mouth of Carmel Valley;

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey certified the Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment for the Project, making the Project eligible for certain grant funds;

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2020, the Resource Management Agency (RMA), in partnership with its cosponsor, the Big Sur Land Trust, submitted a concept proposal letter stating an intention to apply for \$5,147,149 in grant funding for the CRFREE Project from the Department of Water Resources (DWR) Coastal Watershed Flood Risk Reduction Program;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors' approval to submit a full application to compete for these grant funds by the November 20, 2020 deadline will provide the County an opportunity to secure needed additional funding with which to progress with the CRFREE Project; and

WHEREAS, authorizing RMA to submit a grant application for the CRFREE Project supports the Board of Supervisors' Strategic Initiatives for Administration, Infrastructure, and Public Safety because if the County secures grant funds, its cost to provide sustainable physical infrastructure offering flood protection and habitat benefits for County residents will be lessened.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the following:
