





## PROJECT SITE PLAN




Co-location of wireless communication facility








#### **Coverage with Proposed Project**




## PROJECT REVIEW & APPROVAL

- Planning, Public Works, Environmental Services, Environmental Health Bureau, North County Fire
- North County LUAC review on September 16, 2020
  - Unanimous vote of support (6-0)
- > Zoning Administrator approved project as proposed

#### ZA APPROVAL APPEALED


- County Right-Of-Way and perceived lack of access
- Contention that documentation of the application is flawed and findings in approved Resolution aren't correct, including CEQA exemption.
- Contention that County exhibited bias against the appellant.

MCC Regulations: wireless communication facilities shall comply with all FCC rules, regulations, and standards.



### **COUNTY RESPONSES**

Documentation of the application is sufficient. The findings in the draft Resolution are sufficiently supported, including CEQA finding.

County has not exhibited bias against the appellant.



### RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Deny the appeal of the October 29, 2020 Zoning Administrator approval;
- 2. Find the project categorically exempt per section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines; and
- 3. Approve Coastal Development Permit for a new wireless communication facility.
