Support a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to:

a. Accept additional fund augmentation from the Government Operations Agency, California Complete Count - Census 2020 Office ("CCC Office") in the amount of \$90,517 ("Additional Fund Augmentation"), for the purpose of supporting 2020 Census efforts in the Non-Response Follow Up ("NRFU") period in the following priority Census Tracts with a Hard-to-Count ("HTC") Index of 69 and above through October 31, 2020;

b. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Adopted Budget, Fund 001, Appropriation Unit CAO024, increasing appropriations by \$90,517 funded by the Additional Fund Augmentation;

- c. Approve and ratify execution by County Administrative Officer of an Amendment No. 2 to Standard Agreement #CCC-18-20021 with the CCC Office, for the purpose of supporting 2020 Census efforts in the NRFU period, adding \$90,517 for a total contract liability of \$531,963.00 and for the full term of March 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020; and
- d. Approve a one-time investment in the 2020 Census Monterey County outreach efforts, financed from a release of \$300,000 from the cannabis assignment (BSA 3132).

ACTION: The Committee received a report with a request for additional funding needs for the 2020 Census. Budgeting recommendations were provided to staff, and a presentation will be given to the Board of Supervisors in August.

- b. Approve the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority and the County of Monterey regarding the litter abatement program for an amount not to exceed \$100,000, and a period concluding June 30, 2021.
- c. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Adopted Budget, General Fund, Fund 001, Litter Control Appropriation Unit RMA002, decreasing appropriations and estimated revenue by \$75,000. (4/5th vote required)
