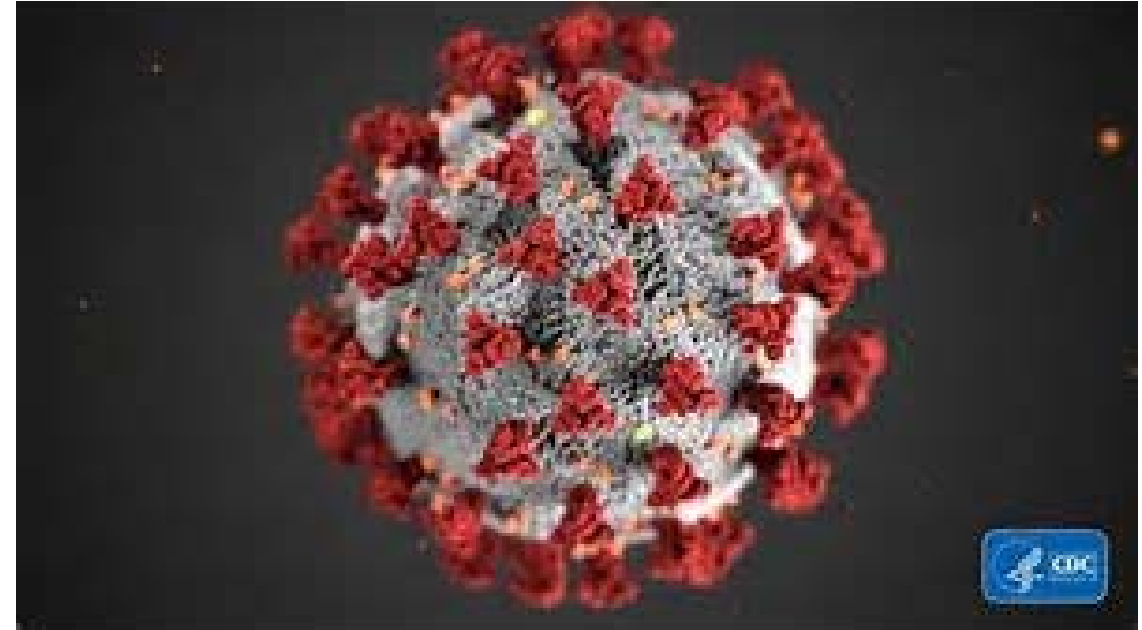

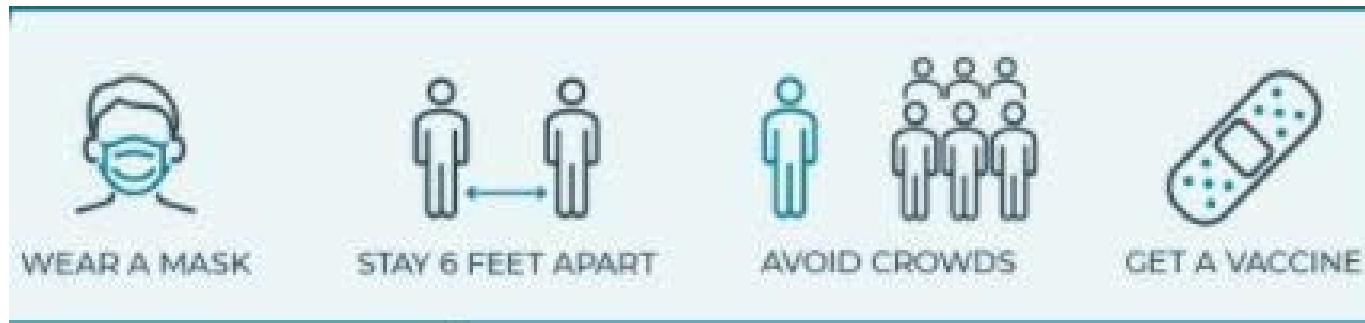
# Monterey County Rolling 7-Day Daily COVID-19 Case Rate per 100,000 Residents as of April 5, 2021



# Strategies to Further Reduce Transmission of COVID-19

# Beyond the Blueprint

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On June 15, California will fully open its economy if two criteria are met:

- If vaccine supply is sufficient for Californians 16+ years who wish to be vaccinated; and
- If hospitalization rates are stable and low

Statewide masking requirements will remain in effect

Testing or vaccination verification requirements will remain in relevant settings





# Updated CDPH Guidance

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## Updated Gatherings Guidance (Effective April 15):

- Some indoor live events and performance can begin (except Purple Tier) with modifications (in-state only attendees, advanced ticket purchase, separate eating and drinking areas). Capacity limits also apply but may increase with proof of vaccination and/or negative test.
- Fairs were added under “Amusement Parks.”

## Youth Sports Guidance:

- Spectators and observers are permitted pursuant to Outdoor Seated Live Events and Performances Guidance.
  - *Limitations still exist for Indoor Sports until such time as Indoor Seated Live Events and Performances goes into effect.*
- Inter-team competitions, meets, races, or similar events are permitted to occur only with other teams within the state.
  - *Removes the limitation for cross-county competitions with only those that share a border.*



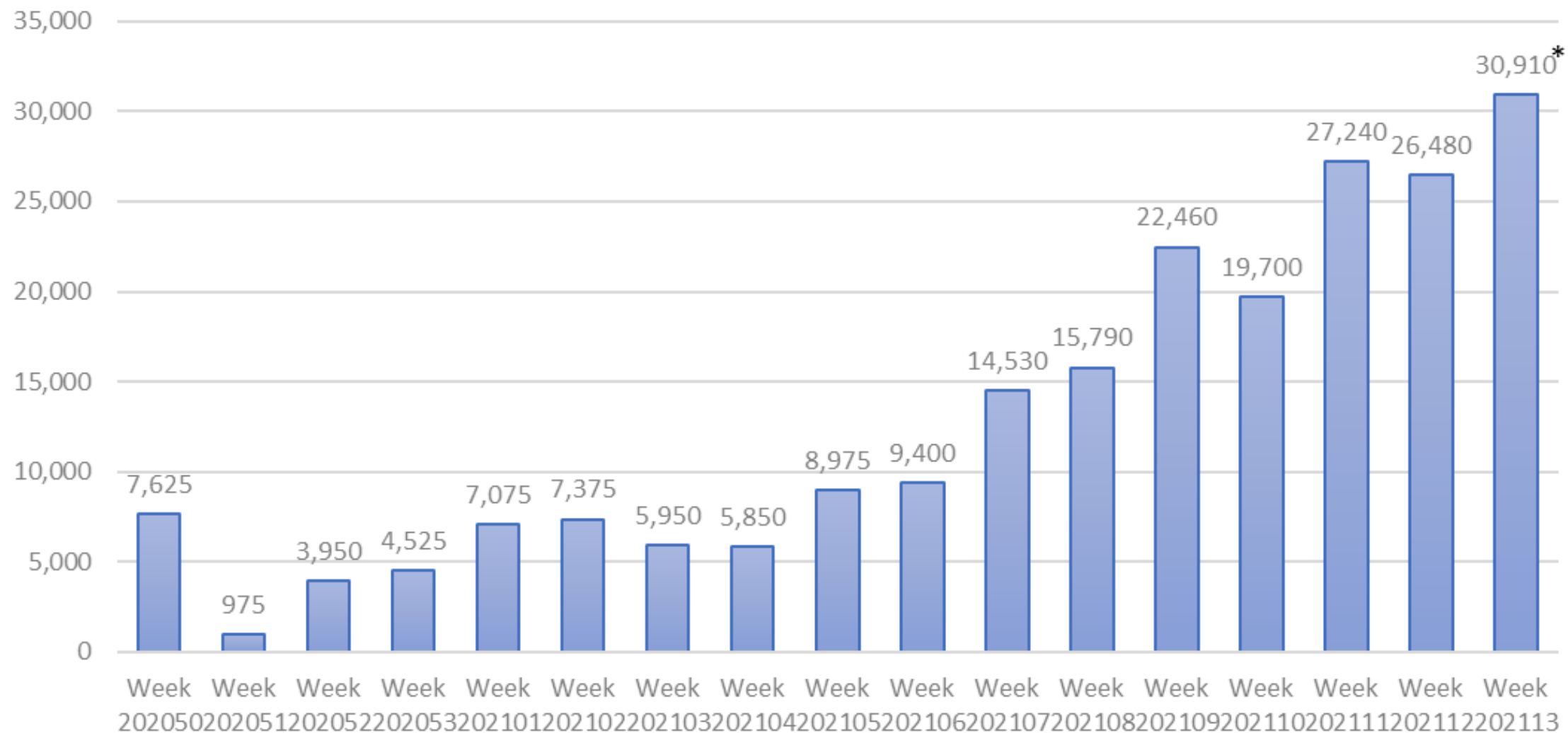
