- Exempt Projects (without Mitigation Measures):
 - Monitor compliance in the same manner



BACKGROUND

 A fundamental purpose of CEQA is to reduce significant environmental impacts of land use projects when feasible to do so (Pub. Res. Code sec. 21002)



- Identify feasible measures or project changes to mitigate impacts (through Mitigated Negative Declaration or EIR)
- Adopt feasible mitigation measures through permit conditions, agreements or other measures (Pub. Res. Code sec. 21081.6(b)
 - Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program
- County must adopt a program for monitoring and reporting on adopted mitigation measures to ensure implementation


