


# Ordinance to Amend Chapter 16.10

## Chapter 16.10 – Digging and Excavation

- December 13, 2005: adopted Ordinance 5012 enacting Chapter 16.10
- Army's military base
- Parcels containing unexploded ordnance and explosives (UXO)
- Clean up of UXO to the standard of CEPA and DTSC
- Land use covenants providing additional controls and restrictions to protect public health and safety

#### **Recent Events**

2020 – trespasser within the Former Fort Ord utilizing a metal detection device, posing a public safety concern.

•DTSC and U.S. EPA recommended local code changes

Staff consulted with DTSC

March 23, 2021 – introduced, waive reading, and set a public hearing

## **Proposed Changes**

- Add Section 16.10.042: prohibit any person from engaging in any unauthorized metal detection activity on property located within the former Fort Ord in the unincorporated area of Monterey County
- Prohibition does not prevent metal detection activity authorized by the County or state/federal agency for remediation or similar purposes.

#### Recommendation

- Find the ordinance Categorically Exempt Section 15308
- Adopt the ordinance amending Chapter 16.10 to prohibit unauthorized metal detection
