



# Modified Blueprint Metric Tier Status

Monterey County Blueprint Metrics for Week of May 9 – May 15	Tier 1 (Widespread)	Tier 2 (Substantial)	Tier 3 (Moderate)	Tier 4 (Minimal)
Adjusted Case Rate: <b>1.9</b>	>10	6 to 10	2 to 5.9	<2
Test Positivity Rate: <b>1.0%</b>	>8%	5% to 8%	2% to 4.9%	<2%
HPI Lowest Quartile Test Positivity Rate: <b>1.1%</b>	>8.0%	≤8.0%	<5%	<2%



# Beyond the Blueprint - Effective June 15

## Indoor and Outdoor Requirements and Recommendations Remaining after June 15

<b>Vaccine Verification / Negative Testing</b>	Required for <b>Indoor</b> mega events Recommended for <b>Outdoor</b> mega events
<b>Capacity Limitations</b>	No restrictions
<b>Physical Distancing</b>	No restrictions for attendees, customers and guests
<b>Masking</b>	Follow current <a href="#">CDPH Guidance for Face Coverings</a>
<b>Travelers</b>	Follow <a href="#">CDC</a> recommendations and <a href="#">CDPH Travel Advisory</a>



# Beyond the Blueprint - Effective June 15

---

- Indoor Mega Events over 5,000 attendees (example: conventions, conferences, expos, sporting events and concerts):
  - Verification of fully vaccinated status or pre-entry negative test result is required of all attendees.
- Outdoor Mega Events over 10,000 attendees (example: music or food festivals, car shows, large endurance events and marathons, parades, sporting events and concerts):
  - Verification of fully vaccinated status or pre-entry negative test result is strongly recommended for all attendees. Attendees who do not verify vaccination status should be asked to wear face coverings.

# Strategies to Further Reduce Transmission of COVID-19

---

- Get vaccinated
- Wear a face covering
- Avoid gatherings
- Wash hands frequently
- Practice social distancing
- Get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms
