RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Supervisors:

Appoint the Monterey County Farm Bureau representative to the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Directors (Jason Smith or Kevin Piearcy - term ending December 31, 2026 (Full Board)).

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Under the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Act ("Agency Act"), the Monterey County Farm Bureau nominates two persons from whom the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Supervisors appoints one Director to the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Directors. Director Jason Smith term expires December 31, 2022.

Sections 48 and 49 of the Agency Act provide:

- a. That the Agency shall be governed by a Board of Directors;
- b. The manner of appointment of those Directors;
- c. The number of Directors; and
- d. The qualifications (experience) of those directors.

In relation to the Director position in question, Section 49(b)(1) of the Agency Act states:

"(b) Four directors shall be appointed by a majority vote of the supervisors from nominees submitted by the following groups or organizations:

(1) One Director from a list of two nominees provided by the Monterey County Farm Bureau, who has a background in agricultural production.

(2) One Director from a list of two nominees provided by the Grower-Shipper Vegetable Association of Central California, who has a background in agricultural production.

(3) One Director from a list of two nominees provided by the mayor's select committee, who has a background in city government within the territory of the agency.

(4) One Director from a list of two nominees provided by the Monterey County Agricultural Advisory Committee. The Monterey Agricultural Advisory Committee shall consider possible nominations from all areas of agriculture not represented by the organizations described in paragraphs (1) to (3), inclusive, such as flower growers' associations, cattlemen's associations, wine grape growers' associations, and independent growers."

Sections 50 and 51 of the Agency Act provide that Directors shall serve a four-year term, and that Directors may be reappointed in the same manner as appointment of the previous holder of the office. The Monterey County Farm Bureau has submitted a letter nominating Jason Smith or Kevin Piearcy as its representative on the Board of Directors. (Attachment 1).

RECOMMENDATION:

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Government Code section 7522.56 limits the manner in which a California Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) retiree can return to public service, even on a temporary basis. Subsection (f) of Government Code section 7522.56 states a retired person is not eligible for a period of 180 days following the date of her or his retirement, unless: "The employer certifies the nature of the employment and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before 180 days have passed and the appointment has been approved by the governing body of the employer in a public meeting. The appointment may not be placed on a consent calendar." At this time, the Water Resources Agency ("MCWRA") seeks Board of Supervisors approval to meet an imminent and urgent need for the critical expertise of a water and flood control engineering specialist intimately familiar with critically needed emergency MCWRA work. This need is heightened given the fact that Monterey County is under a federal, state, and local emergency, and MCWRA staff are staffing EOC in addition to their normal workload.

Brent Buche has 30 years of experience working for MCWRA in many capacities and has his California Professional Civil Engineer's license. During Mr. Buche's lengthy career, he has worked in the operation, maintenance and improvement of every MCWRA owned facility, including numerous pump stations, drainage channels, and dam structures. Mr. Buche held a position on the emergency management team at Office of Emergency Services and responded to numerous County-wide disasters, including bringing flood fighting materials locally from the state. Mr. Buche's recent retirement as General Manager has left a vacancy in MCWRA, and has resulted in a lessened capacity for MCWRA. With the ongoing January 2023 emergency storm events and resulting damage, MCWRA is in need of assistance with emergency flood control response and post-storm damage assessment.
