DISCUSSION:

The staff of the Monterey County Free Libraries (“MCFL”) have successfully applied for a grant from the California State Library for \$24,000 in order to continue provision of literacy services for adults learning English as a second language. Grant activities will occur over the 2023-24 fiscal year, and include individual literacy work with volunteers, workshops, and programs. This grant award will enable the Monterey County Free Libraries to continue enhancing services and opportunities for people learning English and enhancing their reading and writing skills.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has reviewed this item and approved as to form. Risk Management has reviewed and does not recommend the approval based upon non-standard provisions.

FINANCING:

The direct expenses and a portion of staff time devoted to adult literacy services will be funded by the grant award. This grant was anticipated in the Department’s Budget, and additional staff time and grant management, along with incidental additional expenses, are also anticipated in the Library Department’s FY 2023-24 budget.
