SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The County has identified a continued need for Fonseca/McElroy Grinding Company, Inc. (FMG) to provide

Amendment No. 3 will increase Professional Services Agreement (PSA) A-12323 between Monterey County and Fonseca/McElroy Grinding Company, Inc., by \$150,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$450,000, and extend the term to June 30, 2015. The Office of the County Counsel, and Auditor-Controller, have reviewed and approved Amendment No. 3 as to form and legality, and fiscal provisions, respectively.
