In June of 2016, the Director of Health notified the Board of Supervisors and the County Administrative Officer of the intent to submit an application to CCAH for the Medi-Cal Capital Planning Grant in the amount of \$150,000 to support the capital planning activities associated with the development of an East Salinas Behavioral Health Integrated Clinic, which will serve Medi-Cal members and will be located at 331 North Sanborn Road, Salinas, California.

In early September of 2016, Monterey County Health Department was notified by CCAH that it had been awarded the Capital Planning Grant for the maximum total requested. Monterey County Health Department's Behavioral Health Bureau is excited to begin the planning process for the new Behavioral Health Integrated Clinic and approval of the recommended action will allow the Behavioral Health Bureau to receive the CCAH Grant Award and continue to meet the need for quality services and mental health care access for our community.

This work supports the Monterey County Health Department 2011-2015 Strategic Plan initiative to: Ensure access to culturally and linguistically appropriate, customer-friendly, quality health services. It also supports one or more of the ten essential public health services, specifically: 7) Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable, and 8) Assure competent public and personal health care workforce.
