

Friday in December, the supervising authority appoint the qualified nominees who have filed declarations of candidacy.

The person identified is a qualified nominee for candidacy of their respective office and against whom no other nominations were made. Pursuant to applicable law, if no person has filed a declaration of candidacy for any office, the supervising authority shall appoint any person to the office who is qualified, or duly registered to vote in the district, as of the date of the scheduled election, which in this case is November 7, 2017.

The Registrar of Voters recommends that Adrian Ayala be appointed as governing board member to Trustee Area 4 of the North Monterey County Unified School District, for a 4-year term.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The North Monterey County Unified School District has requested that the Registrar of Voters provide all necessary services for the November 7, 2017 School District Election.

FINANCING:

There will be no additional cost to the County General Fund associated with this recommendation.
