## **SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:**

This contract provides project leadership and coordination for Differential Response aka: Pathways to Safety. Differential Response is a strategic way of responding to the reports of abuse and neglect received by Monterey County Family and Children's Services (FCS). This approach to evaluating and improving family and child well-being improves the Department's ability to keep children safe. This is accomplished by responding earlier with a broad range of community based supports to reports of abuse and neglect, before family difficulties

escalate to the point of harm (What Works Policy Brief; Foundation Consortium for California's Children and Youth). Monterey County FCS, in coordination with our community partners, will be working with the ACTION Council to fully develop and support a network of prevention and early intervention. This agreement was delayed coming forward for Board approval due to delayed determination of funding.

#### OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel, the Auditor-Controller and Purchasing have reviewed and approved this agreement.

### FINANCING:

This agreement is funded by Realignment revenues and the Children's Trust Fund. Sufficient appropriations and estimated revenues in SOCOO5 are included in the FY 2012- 2013 Adopted Budget. Approval of this action has no impact on the County General Fund.
