



EMS system throughout Monterey County. Under California law, no person or organization may provide “advanced life support,” also known as “paramedic services,” unless that person or organization is an authorized part of the emergency medical service system of the local EMS agency.

Accordingly, under California law, a paramedic service provider must have a written agreement with the local EMS agency to participate in the EMS system and to comply with all applicable state regulations and local policies and procedures, including participation in the local EMS agency’s Continuous Quality Improvement (“CQI”) program.

The original Paramedic Service Provider Agreement was reviewed and approved by the Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC) on September 14, 2011 and by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors on November 1, 2011. A short extension of the agreement will allow the parties’ time to review and, if needed, revise the agreement to reflect the landscape of our current EMS system.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has approved the Agreement to Retroactively Renew the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement with Cypress Fire Protection District as to legal form.

FINANCING:

This Agreement will have no impact on the General Fund Contribution.
