RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

- a. Approve a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Gonzales and Monterey County Regarding working cooperatively on common planning, growth and development; and
- b. Authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the Memorandum of Agreement.

SUMMARY:

Prior to amendments to Spheres of Influence being considered by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Monterey County (LAFCO), Government Code Section 56425 requires that a city and county consult on the effects of the sphere amendment. The statute requires the parties to discuss the proposed new boundaries and explore methods to reach agreement on development standards. The intent, ultimately, is to provide logical and orderly development of areas within the Sphere of Influence. The attached Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is the result of those discussions. This action is not subject to California Environmental Quality Act for the reasons set forth in the Memorandum of Agreement.
