

approved by its Executive Committee and Monterey County Board of Supervisors. The Probation Department is responsible for implementation and financial oversight of the AB109 Public Safety Realignment plan, distributing a total of \$13,064,817 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 to local organizations supporting the AB 109 Public Safety Realignment community programs in Monterey County.

Turning Point of Central California (Turning Point) has been allocated funding in the amount of \$364,094 to provide Transitional Housing and Emergency Housing Incentive Services for adult offenders eligible for the programs.

Turning Point is a non-profit agency providing services in collaboration with other AB109 funded programs. The agency will provide "Housing First" a Residential Reentry program which offers housing with supervision, programming and support services.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The agreement has been approved by County Counsel as to legal form and by the Auditor-Controller as to fiscal terms

FINANCING:

Funds associated with this recommendation totaling \$364,094 are provided by the State, AB 109 Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011. Funding for all AB 109 programs has been authorized in the current state budget, and is included in Probation's budget unit 8165 for FY 2016-2017. There is no additional cost to the County General Fund Contribution associated with this recommendation.
