



maintains a waiting list that presently stands at over 300. Due to the recent COVID surge, intakes are temporarily paused.

SHARE Center staffing is now full at 20 staff persons on site and one pending. Referrals are received from all areas of the county. Staff has been successful in navigating several persons into permanent housing, in addition to assisting many in obtaining employment. Monterey County Office of Education provides after-school programs and activities for children at the SHARE Center.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Monterey County Department of Social Services and City of Salinas share responsibility and oversight of this program operated by BACS and works closely with the Coalition of Homeless Services Providers.

FINANCING:

This is an informational item only. There is no impact to the County General Fund.
