



periodic screening, diagnosis, and treatment services for children; and topics to expand and strengthen job knowledge, skills and abilities to best serve our community. The agreement provides for one hundred and thirty (130) units/days of training.

UCD requires that the agreement include nonstandard mutual indemnification terms. The Department is recommending approval of this exception to the County's standard indemnity language due to limited alternative resources for these types of trainings.
