



Bronzan-McCorquodale Act (California Welfare & Institutions Code Section 5600 et seq.), Part 2.5 of Division 5 of the California Welfare & Institutions Code, and Titles 9 and 22 of the California Code of Regulations. The Joint Commission requirements for the staff psychiatrist to client ratio on the Natividad Medical Center Behavioral Health Bureau Inpatient Unit make it essential that access to temporary physicians services on an as needed basis be available.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Amendment to the Agreement has been approved by County Counsel as to legal form and Auditor-Controller as to fiscal provisions. The Contract/Purchasing Manager concurs with the Amendment to the Agreement terms. Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. A-11549 is on file with the Clerk of the Board.

FINANCING:

Amendment No. 3 is financed by Realignment and Medi-Cal (Federal Financial Participation) funds. Funding for this Amendment No. 3 is included in the Health Department's Behavioral Health (HEA012, Unit 8410) Fiscal Year 2012-13 Requested Budget. Approval of this action has no impact on the County General Fund.
