



specified schools, and to develop and operate a spectrum of intervention/diversion programs designed to improve behavior in the community, home and school, and prevent further entry into the juvenile justice system.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The MOU has been approved by County Counsel as to legal form, by the Auditor-Controller's as to fiscal terms.

FINANCING:

MCOE will reimburse the Probation Department for a total of \$105,000 for the staffing and operating costs of the programs. Funding for the existing positions is already contained in the approved budget for Department 2550, Unit 8165 for Fiscal Year 2012-13.

There is no cost to the County General Fund with the recommended action.
