

- Increase Accela Automation improvements to \$100,000.
 - Staff is completing the Cannabis Business Permit module and has discovered reporting requirements need improvement.
 - Ordinance work related to MCC Ordinances Titles 20.67, 21.67, 20.69, 21.69, and Chapter 7.90 will continue with an outside consultant.
 - Staff has removed the consultant function to assist with the implementation of the Go-Biz and LJAG grants as it was unsuccessful in identifying an appropriate temporary staff person.
 - The remaining dollars will be adjusted to the passthrough funding for operators who hold a provisional state license and desire to transition to annual licensure.

Staff have conferred with Housing and Community Development to reallocate the grant budget according to Attachment A.
