The COVID-19 Pandemic Disparate Impact Report: Strategies for Addressing the Disparate Impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Communities of Color in Monterey County outlines key areas with short and long term strategies to address risk factors, systemic and institutional barriers that of which the pandemic has demonstrated the most significant impact on Communities of Color.

Key areas include:

- COVID-19 Morbidity and Mortality
- Health
- Environmental Health & Frontline Worker Protections
- Public Assistance for Basic Needs
- Housing
- Homelessness & Housing Instability
- Economic Development
- Justice System
- Legislative Advocacy
- Community Engagement
