SUMMARY & DISCUSSION

Each year the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) invites counties to submit nominations for the CSAC Challenge Awards. These unique awards recognize the innovative and creative spirit of California county governments for finding new and effective ways of providing projects, programs and services to their citizens.

The following is an overview of the program recommended for submission to the 2018 competition.

1. ***Monterey County Juvenile Hall ABC Program:*** Monterey County Probation Department developed and implemented a Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) based behavior modification program to effectively manage youth behaviors within Juvenile Hall.

FINANCING

Each submission to the CSAC Challenge Awards competition requires a \$75 entry fee. Funds are available in the current year budget. Approval will have no additional impact on the General Fund.
