RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION

California Elections Code Sections 10002 and 10400 et seq., provide that a city or district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to authorize the Registrar of Voters to consolidate and render election services relating to the conduct of an election.
