Consider adopting a resolution calling for an election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors (unincorporated County only) of the County of Monterey a countywide measure to raise the retail transactions and use tax (sales tax) in the unincorporated area by 1% (4/5 vote required); and/or
 c. Consider adopting a resolution calling for an election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the County of Monterey a countywide measure to raise the Transient Occupancy Tax by 0.5% for hotels and by 5% for short-term vacation rentals (4/5 vote required); and
 d. Provide additional direction to staff.
