d. Authorize the Interim RMA Deputy Director of Public Works and Facilities to execute the contract and, subject to the terms of the August 28, 2001 Board Order, approve contract change orders where each change order does not exceed \$25,000, plus five percent (5%) of the amount of the original

contract cost in excess of \$250,000; and

e. Authorize the Interim RMA Deputy Director of Public Works and Facilities to execute a Certificate of Completion and record a Notice of Completion with the County Recorder when the Deputy Director

determines the contract is complete in all respects in accordance with the Plans and Special

Provisions for the construction of the 855 E. Laurel, Bldg A-Equipment and Stormwater Management-

Canopy, Project No.8569, Bid Package No.10570, performed by Property Restoration Services.
