Accept the Director of Health's recommendation to incorporate non-standard indemnification and insurance provisions; and</p> <p>c. Approve and authorize the Director of Health or Assistant Director of Health to approve up to three (3) future amendments to each MOU that in total do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the initial liability of each MOU, as shown in Exhibit A, and that do not significantly change the scope of services.</p>
