to June 30, 2019;

c. Authorize the Contracts/Purchasing Officer to sign the County's standard Professional Service Agreement with Ballard Spahr LLP with an exemption to the workers' compensation insurance

requirements;

d. Authorize the Contracts/Purchasing Officer to extend the Agreement with Ballard Spahr LLP for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods under the same scope of work and non-prorated payment
