Approve and authorize the Director of Health, the Assistant Director of Health, or the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency Director, to execute Amendment No 6 to extend the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement between the County of Monterey and Monterey County Regional Fire District on the same terms and conditions for a period from July 31, 2022 to January 31, 2025.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize the Director of Health, the Assistant Director of Health, or the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency Director, to execute Amendment No 6 to extend the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement between the County of Monterey and Monterey County Regional Fire District on the same terms and conditions for a period from July 31, 2022 to January 31, 2025.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency is designated under California law by Monterey County as the local Emergency Medical Services Agency responsible for planning, implementing, and evaluating the local EMS system throughout Monterey County. Under California law, no person or organization may provide "advanced life support," also known as "paramedic services," unless that person or organization is an authorized part of the emergency medical service system of the local EMS agency.

Accordingly, under California law, a paramedic service provider must have a written agreement with the local EMS agency to participate in the EMS system and to comply with all applicable state regulations and local policies and procedures, including participation in the local EMS agency's Continuous Quality Improvement ("CQI") program.

The original Paramedic Service Provider Agreement was reviewed and approved by the Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC) on September 14, 2011 and by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors on November 1, 2011. The current Agreement expires on July 31, 2022. Amendment No 6 extends the Agreement until January 31, 2025 under the same terms and conditions.

This work supports the Monterey County Health Department 2018-2022 Strategic Plan Goals: 2. Enhance public health and safety through prevention; and 4. Engage MCHD workforce and improve operational functions to meet current and

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developing population health needs. It also supports one of the ten essential public health services, specifically: 7. Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable.
