Dear Mr. Angelo,

The Albion Bridge Stewards - in concert with the Highway 1 Coalition and Keep Big Sur Wild - strongly support the preservation of California's historic Highway 1 bridges, which constitute a treasure of local, regional, State, national, and international significance.

The balusters (posts and railings) of the Garrapata Bridge constitute the windows through which the world sees the adjacent magnificent coastal seaand land-scape. As such, they present an essential component of the historic design and construction of the Garrapata Bridge in the Big Sur, and cumulatively all the other Highway 1 bridges of that era along this coast.

The Garrapata Bridge balusters therefore must be properly maintained and, where necessary, repaired or replaced - in kind (height, width, depth) and *in situ* to faithfully and sustainably protect the renowned public viewshed of the Big Sur, as well as public safety. High strength materials are available to do that work. It remains the County's unchanged responsibility pursuant to the State-certified and federally approved Big Sur LCP to permanently protect the public's views through the Garrapata Bridge balusters for unimpaired long-term use and enjoyment.

It has come to our attention that County staff on 24 hours' notice has scheduled a "special" meeting, limited to in-person participation, of the abovereferenced working group to (1) discuss the Garrapata Creek Bridge Rail Replacement Project as briefly summarized in the County agenda for the meeting, and (2) agenda corrections, deletions and proposed additions on which the working group may act pursuant to the Ralph M. Brown Act.

We respectfully submit that no publicly disclosed valid basis exists pursuant to which a special meeting may be called that avoids the Brown Act's general 72-hour minimum notice requirement.

The notice of the special meeting does not identify any action item that is before the working group, which precludes it from taking any action at this meeting, said subpart 2 of the notice to the contrary notwithstanding.

In addition, conducting this meeting solely as an in-person meeting during the

We therefore respectfully request that the County defer this meeting (a) until proper notice of it and its agendized items has been given to all known interested persons pursuant to the Brown Act and the California Coastal Act of 1976, and (b) to such time and place as when the County can conduct an hybrid in-person and web cast meeting of the working group to consider this matter of local and greater-than-local significance.
