Effects of Non-Funding:

- Increase of legal liability resulting from:
 - Diminished response times
 - Increase in complaints
 - Less effective in providing services to residents
 - Exposure to audits by Federal and State agencies
- Potential loss of Federal and State funding resulting from:
 - Non-compliance with State and Federal mandates
 - Failing audits from Federal and State agencies
- A less equitable Monterey County:
 - Loss of commissioner volunteers
 - Difficulty in closing the equity gap
