

# The Pilot Program

- **Six Reconyx Cameras Purchased 8/2024**
- **Service agreement with EPIC iO 8/2024**
- **Lapis Rd cameras installed 9/16/2024 and remaining cameras installed on Trafton and Old Stage Rd. 02/18/2025**
- **All are IR, cellular enabled w/ motion sensors**



# Lapis Rd 2024-2025

- **41 illegal dumping events reported or observed**
- **Cameras help identify four illegal dumpers & citations were issued**



- Assortment of garbage including documents with name and address



# Lapis Rd Dumping- July 30, 2025




7/30 @ 01:58 Motion detected on Monterey Reconyx - Lapis and Del Monte LPR

  - ✓ In-field investigation




# Next Steps


- Relocate Trafton Rd and Old Stage Rd Cameras
