



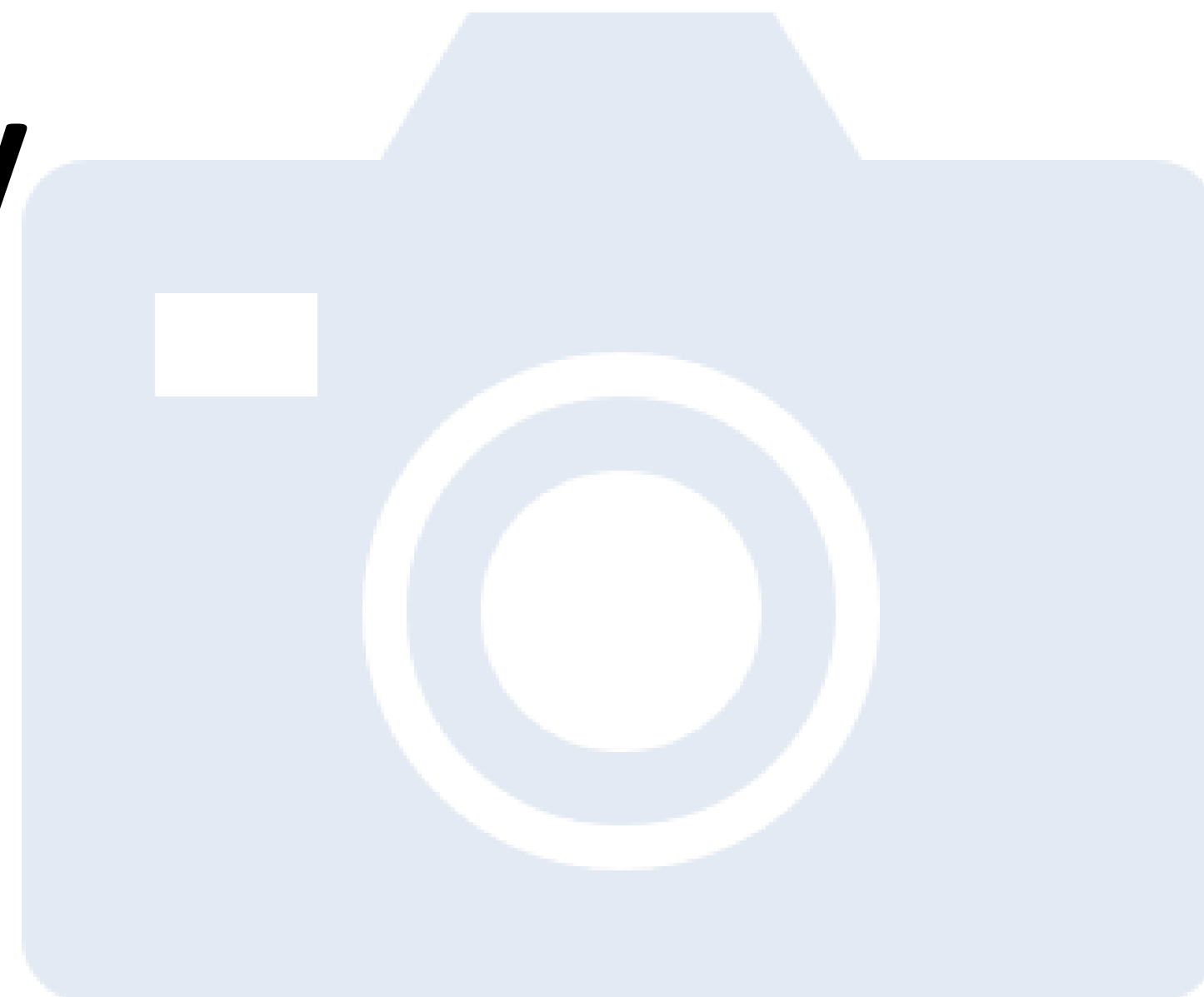

# The Pilot Program

- Six Reconyx Cameras Purchased 8/2024
- Service agreement with EPIC iO 8/2024
- Lapis Rd cameras installed 9/16/2024 and remaining cameras installed on Trafton and Old Stage Rd. 02/18/2025
- All are IR, cellular enabled w/ motion sensors





# Lapis Rd 2024-2025

- 41 illegal dumping events reported or observed
- Cameras help identify four illegal dumpers & citations were issued

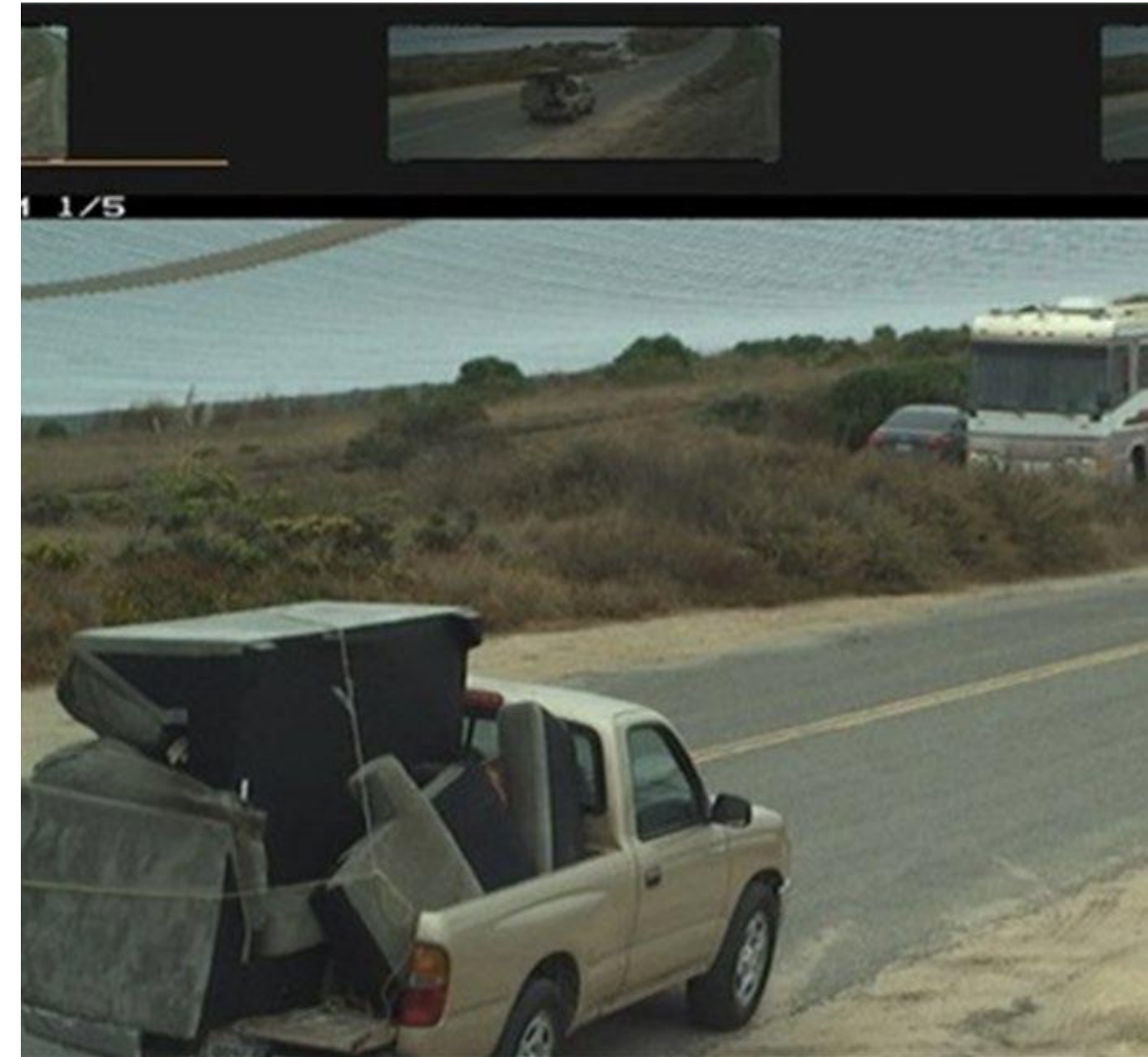
Box Spring Dumper- 09/19/24, 2:18PM

- Reported by ReGen on July 30, 2025
- Approximate time of disposal known
- Assortment of garbage including documents with name and address





# Lapis Rd Dumping- July 30, 2025

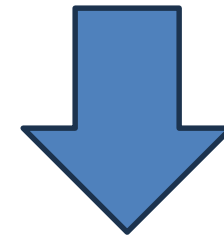




- Entering from the south at 1:58 AM

  - ✓ In-field investigation





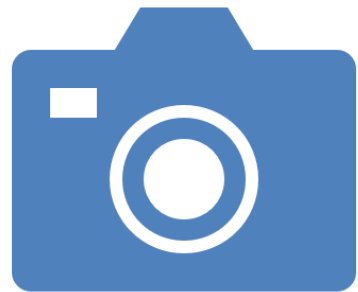
# Next Steps

- Site cameras directly on a “hotspot”

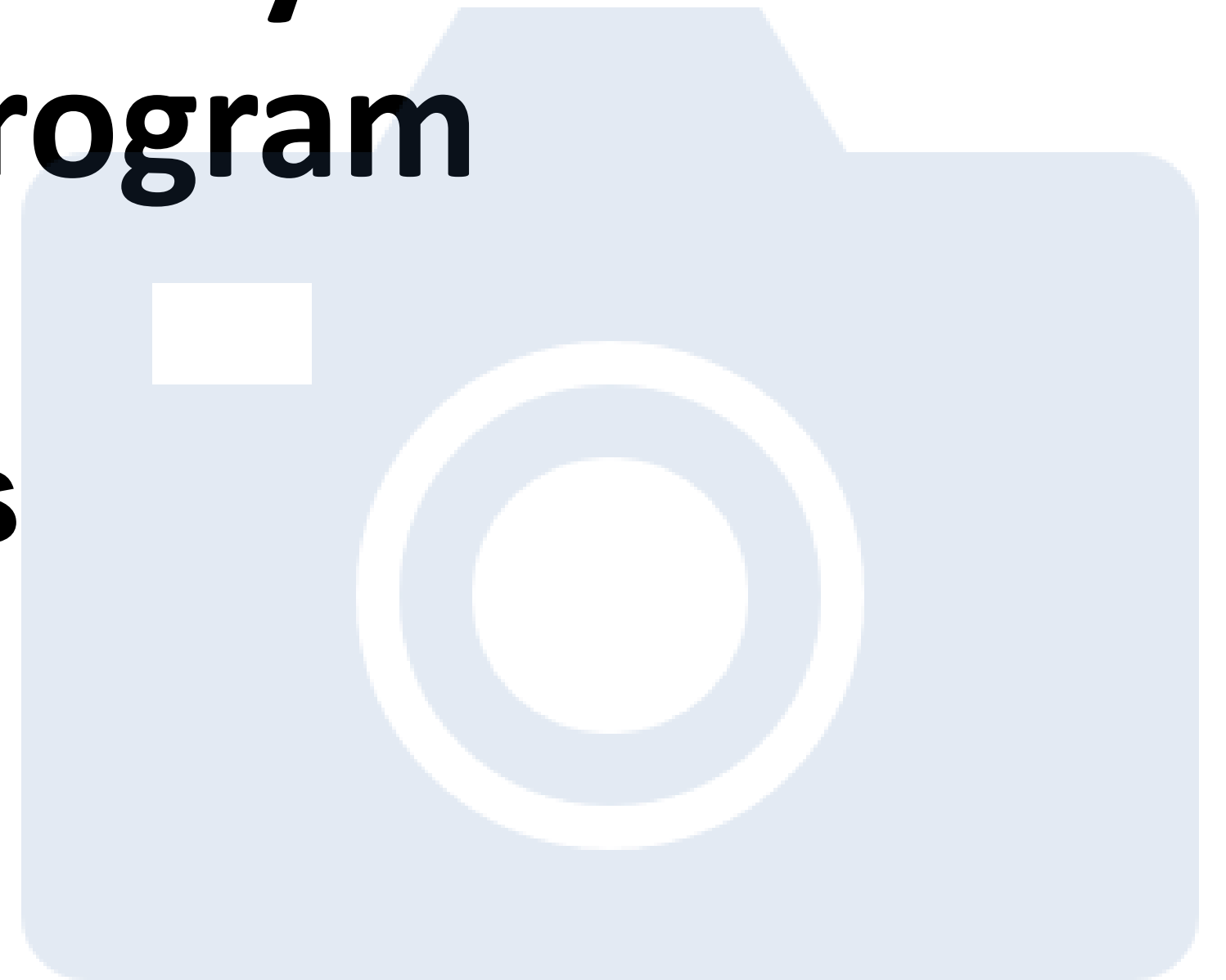
