#### SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The City of Soledad's Veterans Banner Program honors local service members by displaying personalized street banners throughout the city. This request authorizes reimbursement to the City for related program costs using District 3 discretionary funds.

The program promotes civic pride, community engagement, and recognition of veterans' service. It provides a meaningful public benefit by strengthening community connections and fostering appreciation for those who have served.
