

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO STANDARD AGREEMENT
BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND
PAWS HELPING PEOPLE, INC. DBA UNCHAINED**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 to the Standard Agreement between the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter, “County”) and **Paws Helping People, Inc. dba Unchained** (hereinafter, “CONTRACTOR”) is hereby entered into between the County and CONTRACTOR (collectively, “the Parties”) and effective as of the last date opposite the respective signatures below.

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR entered into a Standard Agreement with the County on September 16, 2025 (hereinafter, “Agreement”) to provide a Dog-In-Residence (DIR) Canine Training & Care Academy in conjunction with Canines Teaching Compassion (CTC) program for in in-custody youth housed at Monterey County Juvenile Hall (hereinafter, “services”) for a term beginning January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$48,000; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Services and Payment Provisions require and update to include additional dog handling support services; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is necessary to allow CONTRACTOR to continue providing services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement to update the Scope of Services and Payment Provisions and to increase the Agreement’s amount by \$5,000 for an updated amount not to exceed \$53,000 with no change to the term of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, to allow CONTRACTOR to continue to provide the services identified in the Agreement and as amended by this Amendment No. 1.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend the second sentence of Paragraph 2.01 of Section 2.0, “Payment Provisions”, to read as follows:

The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of \$53,000.00.

2. Update Sub-Section B.1 “Compensation/Payment” of Section B. “Payment Provisions for Exhibit A – Scope of Services/Payment Provisions to read as follows:

County shall pay an amount not to exceed \$53,000.00 for the performance of all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of work as set forth in the Scope of Services.

CONTRACTOR'S compensation for services rendered shall be based on the following budget and in accordance with the following terms:

It is understood and agreed that CONTRACTOR is responsible for costs exceeding \$53,000. CONTRACTOR will leverage additional funding sources to cover the complete cost of services provided under this Agreement.

3. Except as amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement, including all Exhibits thereto, remain in full force and effect as set forth in the Agreement.
4. This Amendment No. 1 shall be attached to the Agreement and incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the Agreement.
