Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Monterey on behalf of the Monterey County Free Libraries and Volunteer Center of Santa Cruz County

This memorandum of understanding establishes a formal partnership between the County of Monterey (County), on behalf of Monterey County Free Libraries (MCFL) and the Volunteer Center of Santa Cruz County (Volunteer Center) to offer classes, workshops, and other learning opportunities.

The goal of this partnership is to enhance and expand opportunities for participation in the programs and activities of the Volunteer Center in Monterey County, through offering classes, workshops and similar learning opportunities at MCFL branch libraries.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the mission of the Volunteer Center of Santa Cruz County is to transform our community and ourselves through volunteerism and empower everyone to be the difference. We connect people, organizations, and businesses to transform lives, build community, and volunteer for good.

WHEREAS, the mission of MCFL is to bring ideas, inspiration, information, and enjoyment to our community. MCFL's vision is that Monterey County is a community where everyone has the opportunity to achieve their potential and pursue happiness.

WHEREAS, through collaboration, Volunteer Center and MCFL are looking to expand opportunities for participation in programs and classes offered by the Volunteer Center, benefitting community members through expanded participation opportunities, and fulfilling the missions of both institutions.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the County and Volunteer Center as follows:

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this MOU is to clearly identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to providing program facilitation to conduct the above activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MOU

The County shall undertake the following activities:

- Provide access to MCFL facilities for Volunteer Center staff, volunteers, and participants for identified activities, on a mutually agreed location, schedule, and duration.
- Provide any current and applicable County and Library access and safety policies and protocols to Volunteer Center.
- Provide directions or training on use of any technology used for Volunteer Center activities at MCFL sites, on mutually agreed schedule.
- Assist in promotion of Volunteer Center activities at MCFL sites.
- Provide an open channel of communication to and with Volunteer Center.

Volunteer Center shall undertake the following activities:

- Ensure that County and Library access and safety policies and protocols are communicated to Volunteer Center staff, volunteers, and participants undertaking the identified activities.
- Ensure that all Volunteer Center staff, volunteers, and participants follow County and Library access and safety policies and protocols.
- Manage all registration and enrollment required for Volunteer Center activities.
- Provide all applicable staff, volunteers, or other oversight as applicable to the Volunteer Center activities.
- Ensure that location and arrangements are safe and suitable for Volunteer Center activities.
- Provide any technology required for Volunteer Center activities that is unable to be routinely
 or suitably provided at MCFL sites.
- Ensure that activities and programs are free of charge and open to the public; Volunteer Center is not permitted to add or imply any fee or charge for those attending.
- Ensure that any additional permits, permissions, licenses or certifications for Volunteer Center activities are obtained and in place.
- Ensure that any personally identifiable information required for participation in Volunteer Center activities is collected, secured, or retained by Volunteer Center, and not shared with or represented as being collected by MCFL.
- Provide an open channel of communication to and with MCFL staff.

TERM

This MOU is in effect upon signing and will be for a term of three (3) years. This MOU may be terminated on terms mutually agreed upon by the parties, or upon 30 days advance written notice, without cause, by either party.

INDEMNITY

In consideration and furtherance of the above specified Volunteer Center shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the County, its officers, agents, and employees, from and against any and all claims, liabilities, and losses whatsoever (including damages to property and injuries to or death of persons, court costs, and reasonable attorneys' fees) occurring or resulting to any and all persons, firms or corporations furnishing or supplying work, services, materials, or supplies in connection with this MOU, and from any and all claims, liabilities, and losses occurring or resulting to any person, firm, or corporation for damage, injury, or death arising out of or connected with the Volunteer Center's performance of this Agreement, unless such claims, liabilities, or losses arise out of the sole negligence or willful misconduct of the County. "Volunteer Center performance" includes their action or inaction and the action or inaction of Volunteer Center's officers, employees, agents, invitees, volunteers, contractors, and subcontractors.

INSURANCE

Evidence of Coverage: Prior to commencement of this MOU, Volunteer Center shall provide a "Certificate of Insurance" certifying that coverage as required herein has been obtained.

Individual endorsements executed by the insurance carrier shall accompany the certificate. In addition, Volunteer Center upon request shall provide a certified copy of the policy or policies. This verification of coverage shall be sent to the County's, Contracts/Purchasing Department, unless otherwise directed. This approval of insurance shall neither relieve nor decrease the liability of the Volunteer Center.

Qualifying Insurers: All coverage's, except surety, shall be issued by companies which hold a current policy holder's alphabetic and financial size category rating of not less than A- VII, according to the current Best's Key Rating Guide or a company of equal financial stability that is approved by the County's Purchasing Officer.

Insurance Coverage Requirements: Without limiting Volunteer Center's duty to indemnify Volunteer Center shall maintain in effect throughout the term of this Agreement a policy or policies of insurance with the following minimum limits of liability:

- Commercial general liability insurance, including but not limited to premises and operations, including coverage for Bodily Injury and Property Damage, Personal Injury, Contractual Liability, Broadform Property Damage, Independent Contractors, Products and Completed Operations, with a combined single limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- Business automobile liability insurance, covering all motor vehicles, including owned, leased, non-owned, and hired vehicles, used in providing services under this Agreement, with a combined single limit for Bodily Injury and property Damage of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- Workers' Compensation Insurance, if Volunteer Center employs others in the performance of this Agreement, in accordance with California Labor Code section 3700 and with Employer's Liability limits not less than \$1,000,000 each person, \$1,000,000 each accident and \$1,000,000 each disease.

Other Insurance Requirements.

All insurance required by this Agreement shall be with a company acceptable to the County and issued and executed by an admitted insurer authorized to transact Insurance business in the State of California. Unless otherwise specified by this Agreement, all such insurance shall be written on an occurrence basis, or, if the policy is not written on an occurrence basis, such policy with the coverage required herein shall continue in effect for a period of three (3) years following the date Volunteer Center completes all the work or performs all the services under this Agreement. Each liability policy shall provide that the County shall be given notice in writing at least thirty (30) days in advance of any endorsed reduction in coverage or limit, cancellation, or intended non-renewal thereof. Each policy shall provide coverage for Volunteer Center and additional insureds with respect to claims arising from each subcontractor, if any, performing work or services under this Agreement, or be accompanied by a certificate of insurance from each subcontractor showing each subcontractor has identical insurance coverage to the above requirements. Commercial general liability and automobile liability policies shall provide an endorsement naming the County of Monterey, its officers, agents, and employees as Additional Insureds with respect to liability arising out of Volunteer Center's work, including ongoing and completed operations, and shall further provide that such insurance is primary insurance to any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the County and that the insurance of the Additional

Insureds shall not be called upon to contribute to a loss covered by Volunteer Center's insurance. The required endorsement form for Commercial General Liability Additional Insured is ISO Form CG 201011-85 or CG 201010 01 in tandem with CG 20 3710 01 (2000). The required endorsement form for Automobile Additional Insured endorsement is ISO Form CA 20 48 02 99. Prior to the execution of this Agreement by the County, Volunteer Center shall file certificates of insurance with the County's contract administrator and County's Contracts/Purchasing Division, showing that Volunteer Center has in effect the insurance required by this Agreement.

Volunteer Center shall file a new or amended certificate of insurance within five (5) calendar days after any change is made in any insurance policy, which would alter the information on the certificate then on file. Acceptance or approval of insurance shall in no way modify or change the indemnification clause in this Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect. Volunteer Center shall at all times during the term of this Agreement maintain in force the insurance coverage required under this Agreement and shall send, without demand by County, annual certificates to County's Contract Administrator and County's Contracts/Purchasing Division. If the certificate is not received by the expiration date, Volunteer Center shall have five (5) calendar days to send in the certificate, evidencing no lapse in coverage during the interim. Failure by Volunteer Center to maintain such insurance is a default of this Agreement, which entitles County, at its sole discretion, to terminate this MOU immediately. Volunteer Center shall be a licensed, bonded and a properly insured (or permissibly self-insured) contractor, and be responsible for restoring the Property to a condition acceptable to the County upon completion of its purpose for using the Property.

NON-DISCRIMINATION/COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS

During the term of this MOU, Volunteer Center and their employees, agents, and/or subcontractors shall not unlawfully discriminate against any person because of race, religious creed, color, sex, national origin, ancestry, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, marital status, age, or sexual orientation. Volunteer Center agrees to comply with all federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances of these authorities, including any health and safety orders or requirements issued by local or state authorities.

GOVERNING LAW

This MOU shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the State of California; venue shall be Monterey County.

ASSIGNMENT

Volunteer Center shall not assign or transfer interest in this MOU to any other parties without written consent from the County.

AUTHORITY

The Parties signing this MOU certify they have proper authorization to do so.
