EMPLOYMENT HISTORY:

Eagle Petroleum – Field operator with responsibilities including steam generating, water handling, oil/water separation, well, steam and water injection. With 24 hour operation of the field, I was responsible to respond to emergencies. Daily operations include well sampling, inspect equipment, assured maintenance scheduling and safety of third party companies, monitor gauges, use computer and other equipment to insure the productivity of the field. Track and record lockout/tag out control procedures and water meter data including steam and generator output.

Kings Oil Tools – Attend and participate in all safety meetings. Inspect and maintain equipment including but not limited to vacuum truck, backhoe, and skipping drag. Troubleshoot wells and perform well packs. Respond to emergency calls at critical wells during off duty hours. Responsible for scheduling my day to day operations with multiple customers and jobsites.

Key Energy – Crane/Fluid Management Supervisor and Operator

Responsibilities: As crane operator I ensure rigs have all supplies needed including pipe, rod, racks and pumps. Clean up location after rig has completed well. Worked with third party companies to replace steam line valves and well trees. Understanding of steam applications and safety protocols. When I worked as supervisor I met with customers to schedule jobs. Supervised vacuum trucks, cranes, and wench truck. Scheduled other equipment such as tanks and pumps. Held tailgate safety meetings. Tracked and scheduled maintenance on all equipment, ensured equipment met the customer's needs and requirements. Maintained log of all work for maximum productivity and tracked water usage. Tracked hours for employees and equipment. Completed employee performance evaluations. Revised standard operating procedures for well packing and polish rod changes to meet customer needs. Reviewed and submitted time tickets. Used a basic computer operating system including Windows, Word, Excel Outlook and other Company specific programs.

Responsibilities: Operate backhoe, excavator, loader, crane, cleaning tanks, Hydro-blasting, performing clean up of hazardous materials and demolition.
