Adopt a resolution recognizing **Rededication of the Castro Plaza Family Resource Center on National Parent Involvement Day and Recognizing the Castroville Coalition.**

**WHEREAS**, the **Castro Plaza Family Resource Center (FRC)** stands as a lasting symbol of community resilience and collective action, originally established through the partnership of local families, the **North Monterey County Unified School District**, and community-based organizations committed to improving access to essential services; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Castro Plaza FRC** has long served as a trusted hub for families in the unincorporated community of Castroville and surrounding areas, providing access to health, education, and social resources that strengthen the well-being and academic success of children and youth; and

**WHEREAS**, the origins of the **Family Resource Center** are deeply rooted in the work of the **Castroville Coalition**, a grassroots partnership of residents and local leaders first formed in 2001 as a response to a need for local input and guidance on the distribution of County of Monterey redevelopment funds and united by a shared vision to build a healthier, safer, and more equitable community; and

**WHEREAS**, **The Castroville Coalition** was instrumental in conducting a 7-year-long intensive process that engaged all sectors of the community regarding how redevelopment activities could have a positive impact on the town of Castroville. The result was the development of the **Castro Plaza FRC** and a local branch of the Monterey County Free Libraries system, and the generation of \$450,000 in addition to governmental resources to launch the Castro Plaza project.

**WHEREAS**, the **Castroville Coalition's legacy** continues to inspire the district's ongoing **student and family support efforts**—uplifting student and family voices, strengthening partnerships, and fostering belonging through shared leadership, collaboration, and community-driven initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, **National Parent Involvement Day** celebrates the vital role of parents and caregivers as partners in their children's education, honoring their leadership, advocacy, and ongoing contributions to building a stronger, more connected North Monterey County community; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Rededication of the Castro Plaza Family Resource Center** marks a new chapter of revitalization—one that honors the past while envisioning a future where every family has access to opportunities, services, and spaces that foster empowerment, equity, and hope;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** the (Monterey country) **North Monterey County Unified School District**, in partnership with community leaders, families, and members of the **Castroville Coalition**, proudly rededicates the **Castro Plaza Family Resource Center** on this day, recognizing it as a cornerstone for family empowerment, community transformation, and collective well-being; and
