WHEREAS, pursuant to the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically Government Code sections 87300 and 87301, the Elections Department of the County of Monterey (Elections Department) has adopted a Conflict-of-Interest Code;

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act requires state and local government agencies to periodically review and make necessary changes to their codes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 87306, the Elections Department has amended its Conflict-of-Interest Code to add one designated position to reflect recent changes in organizations and employee responsibilities;

WHEREAS, the Conflict-of-Interest Code of the Elections Department is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 87303, the Board of Supervisors as code reviewing body may approve the Code as submitted, revise the proposed Code and approve it as revised, or return the proposed Code to the agency for revision and resubmission; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Code is lawful under the Political Reform Act of 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the Amended Conflict-of-Interest Code of the Elections Department, attached hereto as Exhibit C, and directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to notify the Elections Department of its approval.
