Beyond guiding artistic initiatives, the Arts Master Plan will also serve as a policy and planning tool to advise the Board of Supervisors on arts and culture strategies. It will promote collaboration across local jurisdictions, educational institutions, and community organizations; encourage cultural preservation and diversity; and strengthen partnerships between public, private, and nonprofit sectors. Ultimately, the Monterey County Arts Master Plan will ensure that art and culture are recognized as essential components of community well-being, local identity, and economic development, helping shape a more connected, creative, and resilient Monterey County.
