Approve expenditure of \$18,000 to fund the Spay Neuter Imperative Project, California (“SNIP”) for costs incurred performing rabies vaccinations for dogs and cats to be drawn equally in the amount of \$9,000 from District’s 2 and 3 discretionary funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

Approve expenditure of \$18,000 to fund the Spay Neuter Imperative Project, California (“SNIP”) for costs incurred performing rabies vaccinations for dogs and cats to be drawn equally in the amount of \$9,000 from District’s 2 and 3 discretionary funds.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

If approved, the money will be spent on reimbursing and compensating SNIP for costs incurred while conducting rabies vaccinations on dogs and cats.
